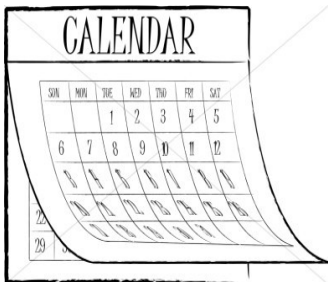

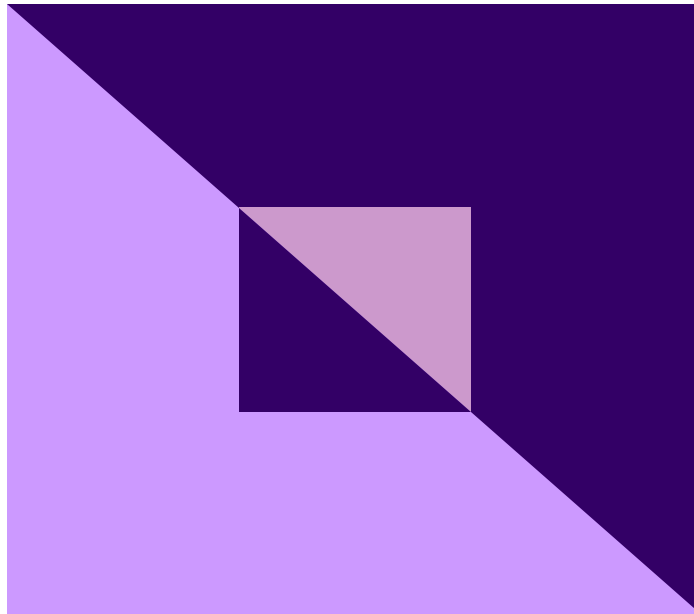
THIS WEEK AT MLA.....
